Mary Ann Cady homesteaded NW1/4 sec 26 twp 34N R 7E and SW1/4 sec23 34N R7E.

Mary Ann Carter was born 5 July 1847 in Pennsylvania to Billings and Sarah Carter.Mary Ann and John Thompson Cady were married 20 Sept 1863 in Fairbury, Illinois.John T. Cady was born in Feb 1833 in Indiana, died 13 Nov 1906 in Kankakee, Illinois. He served in the civil war from Illinois. Mary Ann and John T. had 10 children; Olive, James, Otis, Sarah, Evelyn, Arthur, Josephine, Hattie, Lorenzo, and Goldie. Two of Mary Ann's children came to Montana, James Elliot and Goldie Vern.

James Elliot Cady, born 17 June 1868 in Illinois and his wife, Agnes Whelchel, born 1 Jan 1880 Iowa, remained on their homestead and bought Mary Ann's homestead from her. They adopted J.Elwin Cady. They had no children of their own. James Elliot died 27 March 1945 and Agnes died 12 March 1952. They are both buried in the Joplin Cemetery.

Goldie, born 18 July 1893 in Illinois, was married to Curt Phillips. Goldie had Curtis LeRoy "Roy" Phillips, 25 Nov 1913, and Beaulah Marygold Philips, 12 Oct 1915 in Joplin, MT. Goldie and Curt divorced, and she married 26 Oct 1917 to Ed Warner and had Emma, Donald, Eddie and Billy in North and South Dakota. Curt returned to the area. He married Teddy from Australia. They had Glen, Kathy, and Diane who all attended school in Joplin, where Teddy was a teacher for many years. Goldie died in June 1994.

Mary Ann Carter Cady died 5 Jan 1917 in Reeder, North Dakota.
