

ALIEN REGISTRATION

The following article was found and taken from the Tree Climber publication out of Aberdeen, South Dakota. The article was written by David Revo of Marshalltown, Iowa.

* * * * *

Alien registration got its beginnings with the Alien and Sedition Acts of 1798. Masters or Commandors of any ship or vessel were on arrival to report in writing to customs officials all aliens on board his vessel, specifying their names, age, place of nativity, the country from which they shall have come, the nation to which they belong and owe allegiance, their occupation and a decription of their persons. Customs officials were to transmit such reports to the Department of State. These Acts also gave the President of the United States the power to deport those aliens who were deemed dangerous to the peace and safety of the United States. This act was difficult to enforce and expired in 1800.

Registration resumed again under the naturalization act of 1802. Under this act all free white persons of the age of 21 years being aliens and desirous of being United States Citizens were required to register with the clerk of the district court or other court of record. They were to provied to the clerk of the court the following information: name, birthplace, age, nation and allegiance and place of intended settlement. This portion of the law was repealed in 1828.

With the commencement of the War of 1812, the Aliens Act, one of the infamous alien and sedition acts of 1798 was reinstated. Under this act the department of State issued a public notice requiring all British subjects to report to U.S. Marshals in their stateor territory: name, age, length of residence in the United

States, names of members of their families, place of residence, occupations, and whether they had applied for naturalization. The marshals were instructed to make returns of these reports to the State Department. This act expired in 1815. Registration of aliens did not commence again until the Alien Registration Act of 1929. Aliens were required to make a showing to the Commissioner General of Immigration that they: (1) entered the United States prior to 3 June 1921; (2) Had resided in the United States continuously since such entry; (3) were persons of good moral character; and (4) were not subject to deportation.

This act was subsequently followed by the Alien Registration Act of 1940 which is in a modified form the present law. It called for all aliens, fourteen years of age and over to be registered and fingerprinted. For those aliens under the age of fourteen, their parents were required to register for them. All registration and fingerprint records were to be forwarded to the Justice Department in Washington, D. C.

In 1952, this Act was amended requiring that on the first of January and within thirty days from that date that aliens report their current address and any changes of address to the Attorney general using forms obtained from the post office.

Currently aliens are no longer required to report their current address each January to the post office. This was discontinued in 1981. Aliens are still required to report any change of address which are made directly to the Immigration and Naturalization Service. Now aliens, age fourteen and over, are still required to register and be fingerprinted.

The following article was submitted by our member Maxine Ward. Emmett MARTELL was the grandfather of Stella Ward THISSELLE, Lila Ward LAAS AND Aden WARD all living in Chester, Montana. This article was written by one of his great grandchildren as a school assignment in the late 1950's.

EMMETT MARTELL

Emmett MARTELL left Iron River, Wisconsin in 1905 following the death of his first wife. He left his five children there with relatives. The children were (1) Laura, later Mrs. Les WARD, who passed away in 1970, (2) Mable, later Mrs. Bill TURNBOW, now residing in Oregon, (3) Matilda, who married Jacob SCHAFER and until her death in October of 1972 resided in Havre and East Glacier Park, Mont., (4) Marie, married to Andrew GUSE, now resides in Oregon, and (5) Albert the only MARTELL son, who served in WWI and later passed away in Chester, Montana in 1954. MARTELL also had three adopted daughters who passed away during childhood in Wisconsin. Laura and Tillie stayed in LaCrosse, Wisconsin with relatives and Mable, Marie, and Albert, nickname Curly, stayed in Iron River.

Emmett MARTELL traveled alone across the plains to Stavely, Alberta, to homestead. In two or three years he went once again to Wisconsin and collected his five children who returned with him to Stavely, Alberta. In 1908 he sold his homestead at Stavely and came to Chester, Montana. In 1909 he filed a homestead on 160 acres which were two miles south and one half miles west of the city of Chester.

On April 8, 1910 Emmett MARTELL, four of his children, Mable, 15, Matilda 13, Albert 11, and Marie 8, along with Bill TURNBOW and RALPH WALDEN CAME BY COVERED WAGON FROM Stavely, Alberta to Chester,

Montana. Laura 18 remained in Canada. The trip took nine days and the group was in the Sweetgrass for a day and a half going through customs.

The MARTELL children took turns driving Bill TURNBOW'S horse and buggy. At night the men slept under the wagons and were frequently damp in the morning from the night air and dew. Tillie, Mable, Marie slept in the wagons on the journey. Some of the buildings in Chester when they arrived were Chester Trading co., The Prairie Inn., The Chester Hotel, The Grand Hotel, in addition to the white school house, which is now owned by Montana Power Co. The children went to school for a few terms. Among the first people the MARTELLS met upon coming to Chester were the TAXCARDS, who ran the post office and the CROWES.

Coming from Wisconsin to meet Emmett and family were his brother Carl MARTELL, his wife Eva and her children Lila and Les WARD. Bill INGELL also came from Wisconsin to Montana with the Carl MARTELLS IN 1910. Les WARD rode in an emigrant car and brought furniture and one Jersey cow from Iron River, Wisconsin. Among the children attending school at the same time were Olga NESS and Lottie SHEPHERD. Because the school was too crowded some classes were held at the Chester Hotel and the Prairie Inn. All grades 1-8 were held in the same school then.

While on the homestead dried cow chips were for fuel which prompted words for a verse of a song:

"Oh, Montana Land, sweet Montana Land
While on this buring soil I stand
and wonder why it never rains upon
these buring plains.

And the ladies with their turned up nose
gather chips of buffaloes."

Neighbors often gathered for dances at various homesteads. Among the closest neighbors were STECKS, BILES, MRS. POOTS AND CASHES. A dance was held at MARTELLS in August of 1911 to

celebrate Les WARD's 21st birthday. Among some at the dance were Spellman BILE (lived on the WARRINGTONS place), some STAUDACHERS, and George HUNNEWELL was on hand to play the violin. It was at this dance the Emmett MARTELL met Mrs. VILLEAUX whom he married in 1911. Mrs. VILLEAUX'S children Ernest and Helen lived with her at the time and her other children included Jane SMITH, Mrs. BLANCHARD, Bill VILLEAUX and Mary LAZER.

Several of the men went to the mountains near Libby during the winter to work in logging operations there.

Mrs. VILLEAUX and Emmett were seperated in 1919 after having moved to Seattle. Emmett then returned to Chester and worked by day as a carpenter and also rented various farms. He built the house in Chester now owned by Paul Overlie.

Emmett MARTELL passed away IN 1948 at the age of 97. His survivors were: Laura (Mrs. Les WARD)

Mable (Mrs. Bill TURNBOW)

Tillie (Mrs. Jacob SCHAFER)

Marie (Mrs. Andrew GUSE)

Albert (Never Married)

Several of Mr. MARTELL's grandchildren and great-grandchildren still live in Liberty County.
